## **Background**

Fire and explosion hazards in industries are latent in nature and cause heavy losses to men, material, machinery and environment. It is often easier to prevent fires in the starting than to control or extinguish them once they have started. Therefore, there has been increasing emphasis on fire prevention as one of the most cost-effective measures in dealing with the fire problems in industries. Further it is mentioned in the Factories Act 1948 under Section 38 that all practicable measures should be taken in the factories to prevent outbreak of fire and its spread both internally and externally. Adequate facilities and technical abilities of the manpower are key elements for effective prevention of fire hazards. This fire safety education training kicks off with ways to identify workplace fire hazards and procedures on preventing them. It then demonstrates the importance and proper usage of fixed extinguishing systems, alarm systems like smoke alarm, and portable fire extinguishers. It also includes a lesson on the different parts of an exit route, as well as its basic requirements.
