The Regional Labour Institute, Chennai, one of the Sub-ordinate Offices of DGFASLI, has been rendering technical assistance and services in the field of Occupational Health, Safety and Environment in the Southern Region. RLI Chennai also organizes training programs, conduct courses on OSH.

Program Background

Industrial workers in their day-to-day work are exposed to various kinds of health hazards at workplace. Occupational diseases resulted due to workers exposure to chemical hazards (viz., toxic gases, fumes, vapours, dusts, fibers etc) and physical hazards (Noise, Heat etc.) Rapid industrialization and recent advances in technology many times brings out unknown hazards, due unawareness these lead to exposure and occupational illnesses among employees at industrial workplaces. To overcome these hazards & there related issues, implementation of the best OSH practices with understanding of Industrial Hygiene, Health & Safety at industrial workplace is essential.

Hygiene tools like Anticipation and recognition of the workplace hazard form a basis for further evaluating and controlling such hazards. Several provisions in the Factories Act, 1948 mandate compliance towards providing of safe and healthful workplace at factories in India.

The objective of this program is to make aware participants over theoretical and practical aspects on Industrial Hygiene, its applications as tool in OSHE management, application in Hazard assessment and control at industrial workplace.
