Course Objective

The aim of this training is to provide the participants both theoretical and practical knowledge to enable them to understand the lifting machines, kinematic of load distribution and use of lifting tackles to prevent lifting accidents.

Eligibility

Supervisors working in construction industry with minimum one year experience are eligible to attend the course. Only 50 candidates will be accepted on 'first come first serve basis' to ensure quality learning.

Pattern of Examination

The candidates have to write pre-test as an assessment before the start of the course. Attendance of minimum 80% will be required for the candidates to appear for the final examination, which will be conducted at the end of the course. The candidate must secure minimum 60% marks to pass and be eligible for the award of the certificate. The successful candidates will be provided with certificate.

About DGFASLI

DGFASLI is an attached office of the Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India and serves as a technical arm to assist the Ministry in formulating national policies on occupational safety and health in factories and docks. It also advises factories on various problems concerning safety, health, efficiency and well - being of the persons at work places.

Background

The major cause of accidents in construction sector is due to fall from height and falling objects. This calls for urgent need to protect construction workers from hazards and risks associated with falling material and accidents resulting from failure of lifting appliances.

Material handling is one of the major activities at the construction site. A large number of lifting machines and tackles are employed for handling variety of materials. Safe use of machines is of prime importance at the construction sites. Moreover, manual material handling is also used to a large extent in the construction site.

This safety course has been designed to educate workers and supervisors on various risks and hazards associated with material handling and use of lifting appliances and tackles. It will also provide an overview of risk control, regulations and responsibilities of workers, supervisors and employers. The course will also help the supervisors to understand different rigging operations, safe use of cranes, proper slinging methods so that the lifting is safe and productive.

The course will provide knowledge of legal obligations contained within the OSHWC Code, 2020 and National standards for provision and use of Cranes and other machines, correct terminology and components, and the construction standards required to ensure safe places of work. The course will also provide inspection techniques and the recording procedures necessary to comply with the statutory provisions.
