About the Course/Training Programme:

Safety has become a critical concern in MAH industries dealing with hazardous chemicals & processes, particularly given the rising number of accidents in recent years. These incidents are often the result of a complex interplay of system failures and human errors, with various contributing factors. It is widely recognized that at any stage or level, any mistake or lapse in prioritizing or ensuring compliance with safety measures can have significant consequences, not only for the workers within the industry but also for the surrounding community.

Competency Mapping of the Programme:

Functional Competencies

- Hazard identification & Risk Assessment Ability to identify and assess hazards in MAH industries, and conduct comprehensive risk assessments.
- Safety Management Systems (SMS) Implementation: Ability to implement and manage a robust SMS in MAH Industry by effectively communicating safety procedures, feedback to workers, ability to conduct safety orientations and toolbox talks.etc.

- Accident reporting and Investigation: Determining root causes of incidents and implementing corrective measures.

Behavioural Competencies

- Leadership and accountability: Leading by example, promoting safety behaviours, and ensuring that safety protocols are adhered to by the team while being accountable for safety outcome
- Continuous improvement and learning: in safety practices and professional development.

Domain Competencies

- focus on the specific technical, regulatory, and operational knowledge and skills required to manage safety effectively in Major Accident Hazard (MAH) industries. These competencies are aligned with the unique challenges faced in hazardous industries and are critical for ensuring safety across the entire lifecycle of operations such as Emergency Preparedness, Legal and Ethical Aspects, mechanical integrity, industrial Hygiene & occupational health, safety audit etc.
