The majority of Factories and Ports use some kind of Lifting Appliances (LA) and Loose Gears (LG) for Material Handling. Though the use of LA & LG is an important element, sometimes faulty selection, inadequate strength, patent defects, poor operating practices, etc. may cause serious accidents resulting in injury, fatalities, damage to plant and equipment or other facilities. To prevent such unwarranted events, it is pertinent that users of these equipments are familiar with the various requirements relating to the design, construction, testing and examination, maintenance and safe operation of the equipment. These equipments are also required to be periodically examined and tested as per the provisions under Factories Act / Rules & Dock Workers(S, H&W) Act / Regulations. In consideration of the above, this Institute is providing online training platform for Intended participants to learn from their own place using mobile phone/laptop/desktop (with webcam, microphone & speaker) in view of COVID-19 pandemic situation/preventive measures.
