The warehouse safety hazards can change from moment to moment depending upon;

- The task employees are performing
- The equipment being used
- The substance/materials being handled/stored

The material handling in warehouses either by manually or mechanically can cause accidents and good housekeeping is essential for warehouse safety. It will also allow employees to function more effectively and productively. The Fire and explosion hazard, due to unsafe handling & storage of hazardous chemical in warehouse, can also cause major accidents.

Therefore, Central Labour Institute, DGFASLI Mumbai is providing online training on “**Accident Prevention & Loss control at warehouses**” for Intended participants to learn from their own place using mobile phone/laptop/desktop (with webcam, microphone & speaker) in view of COVID-19 pandemic situation/preventive measures.
