- The comprehensive maintenance includes preventive maintenance monthly / quarterly as per bid and regular services of the various equipment and/or replacement of any items necessary for keeping the listed equipment active and free from any defects/disturbance and on any unscheduled call for corrective and maintenance services.

- Comprehensive AMC includes all spare parts of the equipment. Any defective part of the equipment must be repaired /replaced by the Service Provider at his own cost. Parts so replaced should be new and genuine OEM parts or as prescribed by OEM in their Service Manual and depending on the item under contract.
- Payment will be subject to rules and regulations of Government of India.
- In case the services are not found satisfactory, the contract may be terminated by giving a notice of two weeks.
