About DGFASLI

Background

There are limitations for manual lifting material handling and hence for efficient and fast movement of materials in different working conditions, the use of lifting machines and tackles is essential. It is very important to identify the correct lifting machine for handling of various types of materials in industries, construction sites and port sector. At the same time, selection and application of lifting tackles also play a vital role in efficient handling of materials. Improper selection of lifting machines and tackles for handling of material causes failure of equipments and gears, resulting in major injuries, damage to property, material to be handled and equipment used. These necessities require that the material handling equipments such as lifting machines and tackles be maintained, examined and tested at regular intervals to ensure that they remain safe & efficient.

Therefore, Central Labour Institute, DGFASLI Mumbai is providing an online training platform for intended participants to learn from their own place using mobile phone/laptop/desktop (with webcam, microphone & speaker) in view of COVID-19 pandemic situation/preventive measures.
