About DGFASLI

DGFASLI is an attached office of the Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India and serves as a technical arm to assist the Ministry in formulating national policies on occupational safety and health in factories and docks. It also advises factories on various problems concerning safety, health, efficiency and well - being of the persons at work places.

Background

Many studies have emphasized the importance of human factors in prevention of accidents. It is estimated that up to 90% of all workplace accidents have human error as a cause of accidents. The term “human failure” or “human Error” refers to errors and violations at workplace. Some of the factors contributing to human failure are:

1. Low skill and lack of competency
2. Poor design of equipments
3. Unclear Instructions
4. Poor working conditions
5. Poor planning
6. Poorly designed SOPs, etc.

Accidents are caused because of latent conditions which can lead to human failure or human error. It is therefore, necessary to understand the contributing factors to help understand the “ Human Factors “ to design the strategies of “ Accident Prevention”.

This program will help the Safety Officers, Managers and professionals understand the human factors in accident causation and help them in designing organizational processes, systems and strategies for prevention of occupational injuries and diseases.
