Background

Avoiding exposure to the chemicals at industrial workplaces is essential and it is mandatory on the part of management to implement suitable control measure to provide safe work environment. The airborne levels of hazardous chemicals and their concentrations shall be of the values given in the schedule-II framed under section 41F of The Factories Act (1948), well known as Permissible Limits of Exposure (PLE). The lack of understanding and awareness among the workers pertaining to these PLEs for various chemical agents many times lead to occupational illnesses. PLE values must be also considered for the controlling of chemical hazards at workplaces. In light of this, RLI Chennai organizing online training program for the company management, OSH professionals and authorities to orient themselves of chemical hazards and PLE at workplaces.
