Background

“Occupational Diseases” means a condition that results due to an exposure to risk factors such as physical, chemical, or biological agents in a workplace during work activity to the extent that the normal physiological mechanisms are affected, and the health of the worker is thereby impaired.

Occupational health surveillance is the systematic and continuous monitoring of workers’ health in relation to workplace hazards. The overall goal of health surveillance measures is the continuous improvement of safety and health at workplaces and the protection of workers’ health.

Programme Highlights

Proper documentation of health surveillance findings provides a safe basis for employers, employees and occupational safety and health specialists in case of legal claims. Such data can also provide a starting point for scientific research.

- ❖ Clinical and physiological assessments
- ❖ Statutory health surveillance
- ❖ Notification of occupational diseases as an outcome of health surveillance
