Background

A machine is a mechanical device that uses power to apply forces and control movement to perform an intended action. Man since the time in memorial has invented different types of machines, simple and complex, to make their task easier to perform. Machines necessarily require input energy to get a desired output motion to perform a particular task. Machines can be driven by human or animal agency or by natural forces such as wind and water, and by chemical, thermal, or electrical power. From simple machines, like wedges, pulleys, crowbars, etc., to modern machine tools, CNC, SPM, etc., perform tasks in an easier and accurate manner. Though machines are called friends of human they can be a foe if their hazards are not controlled properly. One of the ways to control machine hazards is by way of machine guarding.

Programme Preamble

This program intends to benefit the safety professionals working in industries to understand the hazards of machine operations and ways to identify and control them.
