The main focus of occupational health include promotion and maintenance of working capacity and employee health; improvement of working environment; development of work cultures and organizations to support health and safety; promotion of positive social climate and smooth operation; enhanced productivity of the organization. Occupational health and safety (OHS) standards mandate reduction, removal or replacement of job site hazards. OHS programs also help minimize the effects of such hazards
