These hazardous processes pose serious hazard and risk to the workforce at the premises and even beyond the premises. Unless special care is taken, it may lead to material impairment to the health of persons engaged in or connected therewith or result in the pollution of the general environment. The Factories Advice Service Division, DGFASLI Mumbai is providing online training platform for interested participants to learn from their own place using mobile phone/laptop/desktop (with webcam, microphone & speaker) in view of Covid 19 pandemic situation/preventive measures.
