Also, the logic behind notification of certain Accidents & Dangerous Occurrences is to pave way for creating Corrective and Preventive measures so as to eliminate accidents in future. The Factories Advice Service Division, DGFASLI Mumbai is providing an online training platform for interested participants to learn from their own place using mobile phone/laptop/desktop (with webcam, microphone & speaker) in view of Covid 19 pandemic situation/preventive measures.
