The Iconic Week under the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav is a grand celebration by the Ministry of Labour and Employment, celebrated from 07.03.2022 to 13.03.2022 to showcase its achievements, activities and dedications. Directorate General Factory Advice Service & Labour Institutes (DGFASLI), an attached office of the Ministry, proposes to celebrate the Iconic Week with several activities for improving occupational safety, health and working condition of the workers in the factories, dock works and construction sites.

ABOUT DGFASLI:

DGFASLI is an attached office of the Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India and serves as a technical arm to assist the Ministry in formulating national policies on occupational safety and health in factories and docks. It also advises factories on various problems concerning safety, health, efficiency and well - being of the persons at workplaces.

BACKGROUND:

The outbreak of fire is the result of lack of awareness on the various aspects of fire and its prevention means and measures. Section 38 of the Factories Act, 1948 provides "in every factory, all practicable measures shall be taken to prevent outbreak of fire and its spread, both internally and externally". The ability to control fire is an art towards improved industrial development. The risk is also controlled by fire protection measures in workplace, which relate to both fire prevention & fire control. As a part of the Iconic Week celebration by DGFASLI under the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, an online National seminar on "Fire Safety in Factories, Construction and Docks" has been scheduled to be held on 09.03.2022 from 10.00 AM to 05.00 PM. This seminar is designed to provide insight into the gravity of the fire problem and the means and methods available to improve fire safety under the Factories Act, 1948 and relevant standard.

OBJECTIVES:

- To exchange experience and ideas regarding new approaches, methods & strategies towards fire safety.
- Gap analysis and to find out measures for removing gaps with fire safety.
- To share best practices on fire safety and related issues.
- To promote closer interaction among OSH stakeholders and government functionaries.
- To discuss adequate preventive and control techniques.
