Background

The building and other construction work has a high degree of hazard as compared to other sectors. Construction industry, often termed as 'high-risk', has a significant impact on the safety and health of the workers. Though it is common to see a construction worker work at heights with equipment and building materials, these scenarios are plagued by potentially dangerous situations and poor working conditions. They are exposed to hazards that are difficult to quantify and poses challenges to OSH of the workforce.
