#### **PROGRAMME PERSPECTIVE**

A Major Accident Hazard is a source of danger that has the potential to cause a major incident, whether that involves multiple fatalities and/or significant damage to plant, equipment or the environment. Managing Major Accident Hazards is vital to safe operations.

There are many considerations that need to be put in place by the industries, particularly in terms of its management and safety for the businesses, lives, properties, and environment. The lack in such considerations could very well cause major accidental hazards.

The potential for major industrial accidents, which has become more significant with the increasing production, storage and use of hazardous substances, has emphasised the need for a clearly defined and systematic approach to the control of such substances in order to protect workers, the public and the environment.

This training program is intended to help employers prevent and control MAH incidents by imparting guidance to the employers for identifying the workplace major accident hazards for improving the overall safety performance of the installations.
